CLASSIC CAR SHOW HERE ON JULY 4

Mark Monday, July 4th, on your calendar. The **Second Annual Columbus Square Classic Car Show** is back. It is held in conjunction with the Northland Area Fourth of July Parade, and begins at 12 noon, when the parade finishes on July 4. The Northland parade has been one of the must-see holiday parades in central Ohio for 48 years. The car show benefits a different Northland area charity every year, and this year it is Big Brothers Big Sisters.

"Cars are all we do," said 'Boots.' "I see this car show as a way to share our passion for cars and generate that interest in others. Working on these vehicles is a labor of love. I plan on bringing my 1957 Chevy, 1923 T Street Rod and 1957 Chevy Custom Harley Golf Cart to the show. We invite everyone to join us at Columbus Square on July 4th!"
